Prepared remarks also expanded into how cities and their municipalities should seek opportunities to establish public/private partnerships with companies willing to mentor their youth in STEM and STEM careers. In addition, Kate urged mayors to strongly consider looking to those companies within their jurisdictions who actively demonstrate a commitment to STEM and mentoring for when their agencies need to tap critical STEM-related expertise for various contracts.

At the conclusion of the session, Kate had time to network with each of the mayors, all of whom expressed appreciation for her insight and perspectives. Several have since asked Kate to come and speak directly with their staff and council members.
